Paula was a natural-born leader and former resident of Las Cruces, N.M., she was deeply involved in that community prior to moving to Bailey, Colo. As the co-owner of Front Range Commercial Windows and Doors, Paula was a member of the National Association of Women in Construction and the American Subcontractors Association Colorado (ASAC).

She was dedicated to making a difference in her community and the former president of the Platte Canyon School District School Board, as well as assistant coach to the debate team and a favorite substitute teacher. She received the Colorado Association of School Boards “McGuffey Award” for her committed and passionate service.

Because Paula's legacy is to bring positive and meaningful change to her community and to the construction industry, the ASAC Board of Directors formally approved the ASAC Paula Anzell-Morris Celebration of Life Scholarship March 21, 2018 as a tribute to Paula and the ASAC workforce development initiative.

#### **ASAC Scholarship Criteria:**

- Colorado residents only
- Must be used at accredited Colorado University, College, Vocational or Trade School
- Students must be pursuing a career in the construction industry as a graduating senior or returning to school to pursue an education in the trades, engineering, design, finance, business, law etc.

#### **Education:**

- **Minimum Entry GPA: 2.0**
- Name of high school or secondary institution currently enrolled
- Current G.P.A.
- Attach unofficial transcript from your high school or last college or institute you attended
- Expected graduation date

#### **Community Involvement:**

What community organizations do you or have you in the past been involved with and what were your roles?

#### **Letters of Recommendation:**

Provide 2 letters of recommendation from a friend, supervisor, co-worker, teacher, coach or anyone that can speak to your character and integrity.

#### **Personal Statement (Essay):**

The Personal Statement is an opportunity to give the scholarship committee a peek into who you are, what motivates you, and what your future plans are. Your essay should be no more than 500 words and be printed not written.

Describe your goals after you have graduated and how you will achieve them through your education? Include any relevant information about yourself, what has or currently does motivate you, and why you deserve to be awarded this scholarship. Attach your completed essay to your application.

#### **ASAC Submission and Award Guidelines:**

1. Application opens January 11, 2019
2. Application closes April 1, 2019 – *all Applications must be received at the ASAC office no later than 12:00 a.m. and may be received via USPS, UPS, FedEx, Courier or Email [DScifo@ASAColorado.com](mailto:DScifo@ASAColorado.com).*

**ASAC will confirm receipt of Application within 24 hours of receipt. IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE A CONFIRMATION, YOUR APPLICATION WAS NOT RECEIVED.**

3. Application review process completed by April 30, 2019
4. Notify Scholarship recipients by telephone May 1, 2019
5. Presentation of Scholarship Certificate made at ASAC Annual Awards Gala, Saturday, May 18, 2019.
